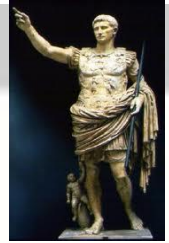

Key Terms

- Verb** A doing word
- Infinitive** The title of the verb (in English it always starts with To...) In Latin it ends on *-are, -ere, -ire*
- Subject** The person/thing doing the action (I, you, he/she/it, we, you, they: *ego, tu, is/ea/id, nos, vos, ei*)
- Object** The person/thing undergoing the action
- Conjugate** What you do to a verb to make sure you are using it correctly (e.g. *amo*: I love)
- Adjective** A describing word - *bonus*
- Agreement** Something you add to the end of an adjective to match it to the noun: *puer bonus, but puella bona*

A as in father
 E as in pet
 I as in pit
 O as in note
 U as in put
 AE as in why
 AU as in house

C as in cot (never as in century)
 S as in bus (never as in busy)
 V pronounced as W
 GN as in hangnail
